

Tuskegee Police officer arrested again on rape charges

TUSKEGEE, Alabama -- A Tuskegee Police officer has been arrested again on rape charges by the Alabama Bureau of Investigation after a second underage female came forward with allegations against the officer.

Levy Kelly, 38, was arrested Jan. 3 and charged with first-degree rape, second-degree sexual abuse and two counts of enticing a child to enter a vehicle or house for immoral purposes, ABI released today.

Kelly is being held in the Macon County Jail.

Kelly was arrested on Dec. 13 and charged with three counts of rape and three counts of enticing a child for immoral purposes.

In 2004, Kelly pleaded guilty in Montgomery County to a misdemeanor charge of impersonating a public servant, according to court records. He was placed on probation.
