## Ex-Grapevine police officer given 15 years in prison for making child porn

A former Grapevine police sergeant was sentenced Tuesday to 15 years in federal prison for producing and possessing child pornography related to his video recording of a boy in a swimming pool.

Philip Woolery also was fined \$5,000 by U.S. District Judge Terry R. Means during his sentencing in Fort Worth, the U.S. attorney's office said.

Woolery, 47, had pleaded guilty in March to one count of production of child pornography and one count of possession of child pornography.

Woolery has been in federal custody since by U.S. Postal Inspectors arrested him in October 2012 while searching his Crowley home.

Woolery admitted that in August 2011 he used his digital camera to record an underage boy masturbating while in a swimming pool. He also admitted to having a laptop computer in October 2012 with a sexually explicit image of a nude boy and that he used the computer to search for child pornography.
