WINSTON-SALEM, N.C. — A member of the Winston-Salem Police Department was arrested after officials said he was involved in distributing child pornography.

Raymond Edward Kish, 34, was charged Wednesday after an investigation by the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation and the North Carolina Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

Police said the child pornography investigation led to Kish's address at 2110 Independence Road in Winston-Salem.

Personal information about the alleged victim or victims has been withheld. Police said the crimes occurred at Kish's home.

Kish was charged with 10 counts of third degree sexual exploitation of a minor. He received a \$120,000 secured bond and has court planned for May 11.

Kish has been a Communications Operator with the Winston-Salem police since November 2010. Police said he has since been placed on administrative leave.
