





Former Nassau County Sheriff's Officer Pleads Guilty In Child Sex Crime

NASSAU COUNTY, Fla. – Alan Jon Manchester, 47, pleaded guilty this week to two counts of Sexual Battery Involving a Minor.

In June 2013, an investigation conducted by the State Attorney's Office revealed that Manchester, a former Nassau County Sheriff's Office school resource officer, had had a sexual relationship with the female victim, beginning when she was 15-year-old. During this time, Manchester impregnated the victim, who is now 22, when she was 15 and 17-years-old.

Manchester now faces up to 30 years in prison. He will be sentenced May 8.
