Celeste Police chief dies of gunshot wound

While facing charges of sexual assault, Celeste Police Chief Roger Eugene Mueller III has died of an apparent selfinflicted gunshot.

According to the Greenville Herald-Banner, police got a call of a gunshot victim at Mueller's home at around 7:45 p.m. Monday night. He was transported to Hunt Regional Medical Center in Greenville, where he died shortly after.

Mueller was indicted on charges of sexual assault of a child after being accused of touching the breasts of a girl of less than 17 years of age on June 1., 2012, and on May 30. If convicted, Mueller would've faced two to 20 years in prison for each charge.
