Retired Conroe PD sergeant arrested for alleged sex assault of a child, compelling prostitution

Conroe police arrested a 70-year-old man after he allegedly paid to have sex with a 16-year-old girl early Saturday morning.

Will Ewing, a retired Conroe Police Department sergeant, is charged with compelling prostitution and sexual assault of a child. Ewing worked for CPD from 1982 to 2003 before retiring.

Jasmine Baker, 21, who allegedly came with the girl to Ewing's Conroe home, also was arrested for sexual assault of a child and compelling prostitution.

Under the Texas Penal Code, a person commits compelling prostitution if he or she knowingly causes a person younger than 17 years old to commit prostitution.

Ewing and Baker are being held in the Montgomery County Jail on \$150,000 bonds.

According to information from the Conroe Police Department, officers responded to a car accident near Longview Street and Meridian Court around 3:30 a.m. Saturday. A caller told police dispatchers that two women fled the scene.

"(A witness) said a car had crashed into their fence and two females were seen leaving the vehicle," Conroe Police Sgt. Dorcy Riddle said.

Once on scene, officers searched the vehicle and learned the vehicle and a wallet inside the car belonged to Ewing, who lives across the street from the location of the accident. When officers went to Ewing's home, they found him along with Baker and a 16-year-old girl.

Through the investigation, Riddle said, officers learned Baker allegedly brought the girl to Ewing's home to complete a "prostitution transaction."
