

Correctional officer arrested for sex crimes : News

Chad Jerome Shaddon, 39, of Kingsburg, a correctional officer with the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation was re-arrested Monday, July 14, after another victim came forward alleging molestation.

The second victim, a 14-year-old female, saw media reports about Shaddon's initial arrest July 11 and told her family about several occasions of molestations at residences in Kingsburg.

Shaddon was booked at Fresno County Jail for multiple counts of lewd and lascivious acts with a child and penetration by foreign object. His bail was set at \$1.5 million until he is arraigned.

Shaddon was re-arrested Monday when he came to Kingsburg Police Department to file a complaint with the Kingsburg Police.

The suspect had initially been arrested July 11 for alleged lewd and lascivious acts with a child and for sexual battery. He was initially released on a bail bond, according to a July 13 Kingsburg Police Department press release.

The mother of that first 15-year-old victim was reportedly in a dating relationship with Shaddon at the time of the alleged offense. The mother brought her daughter to Kingsburg Police Department to report the alleged crime late July 11.
