

## Placer County deputy pleads guilty to sex with minor

- PLACER COUNTY, Calif. (KCRA) —A Placer County sheriff's deputy pleaded guilty in court Wednesday to having sex with a minor.

Kenneth Skogen reached a plea agreement with the district attorney's office on one count of having unlawful sex with a minor, and as a result, will be placed on three years of formal probation after serving 150 days in jail and attending counseling.

Skogen was arrested in July on four charges stemming from an 2011 relationship he had with a 17-year-old who was a volunteer with the Placer County Sheriff's Department at the time, officials said.

The charges included one count of unlawful sex with a minor, one count of oral copulation with a minor, one count of meeting with a minor for the purposes of having sex and one count of communicating with a minor for the purposes of engaging in lewd or lascivious behavior, according to the district attorney's office.

Skogen is eligible to apply for alternative sentencing.

Officials said Skogen is not allowed to be in the presence of minors without their parent or guardian present.

Skogen's formal sentencing is set for Jan. 7 at the Placer County Superior Court.
