

Retired Cincinnati police officer sentenced to 5 years for child porn

CINCINNATI – A retired Cincinnati police officer was sentenced to five years in prison for child pornography charges.

U.S. Customs officers arrested Robert Glassmeyer, 62, last year in Port Huron, Michigan after returning from Ontario, Canada. An inspection turned up a video camera with several images of child pornography, according to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement officials.

Glassmeyer was charged with possession and transportation of child pornography.

“This sentence underscores the particularly heinous nature of these crimes, Marlon Miller, Homeland Security Investigations Detroit special agent in charge, said. “Sadly, the individuals involved in these depraved crimes can come from trusted elements of our society, which only serves to strengthen HSI’s resolve to pursue these predators.”

The investigation is part of Homeland Security’s Operation Predator, an international initiative to protect children from sexual predators.

Since the launch of Operation Predator in 2003, agents say they have arrested more than 12,000 people for crimes against children. Charges have included the production and distribution of online child pornography, traveling overseas for sex with minors and child sex trafficking.
