

Retired St. Louis police lieutenant faces child porn charges

ST. LOUIS • A retired St. Louis police lieutenant is facing four counts of possessing child pornography.

Ronald G. Oldani, 65, of the 5600 block of Murdoch Avenue, posted 10 percent of a \$40,000 bail Tuesday. He was charged last week.

Earlier this year, the department's Cyber Crime Unit identified him as a suspect. He was booked in October pending the application of a warrant and the forensic examination on seized evidence was completed.

According to court documents, Oldani had child pornography on computer and flash drives. Police found more than 100 multimedia files containing child pornography on his computer, 17 of which contained identified victims. Oldani admitted the computer belonged to him and admitted to downloading child pornography on the computer,

court documents say.

Oldani served on the department from 1979 to 2009.
