

Maypearl city leaders: No further action against police chief who resigned

Members of the Maypearl City Council and a city attorney decided Saturday that they would take no further action against former Police Chief Kevin Coffey, who resigned this week following his arrest on child sex charges.

Coffey, 49, was arrested Wednesday on counts of child sexual assault and indecency with a child. He is accused of having a sexual relationship with two teenage girls.

Coffey, who was named chief in 2013, remained in the Ellis County Jail in lieu of \$350,000 bail Saturday.

On Wednesday, the city said in a prepared statement that Coffee would no longer be police chief, but it was unclear if he had resigned or been fired. Mayor Adele Mooney said Saturday that Coffee resigned, meaning the council could take no further action against him.

The city will begin looking for a new police chief immediately.
