Report: Central Texas officer arrested on child prostitution charge

2015 Cop Pedophile solicit minor for prostitution Steve Canava

A Central Texas law enforcement officer has been arrested and charged with soliciting a prostitute under the age of 18, a second degree felony punishable by up to 20 years in prison.

Steve Canava, a 51-year-old deputy constable for McLennan County, was arrested Friday, The Waco Tribune-Herald reported.

McLennan County Sheriff Parnell McNamara told the Tribune-Herald that Canava had been an officer for "many years."

A LinkedIn page for Canava says he worked as an officer for the Waco Police Department from October 1988 to October 2009, when he became a deputy constable.

Canava was later released from McLennan County Jail, according to jail records and the Tribune-Herald.
