Yuma police have arrested a former Cocopah police officer and current Rural/Metro Fire Department employee who is suspected of being involved in a sexual relationship with a 13-year-old female.

Appearing before Yuma Justice of the Peace Greg Stewart Friday, 41-year-old Brian Wolgamot was informed that he was being held on seven separate felony counts of sexual conduct with a minor.

After telling Wolgamot that he had found that there was probable cause as to the arrest,

Stewart informed him that the county attorney's office had two days to determine whether to file a criminal complaint against him, charging him with any of the offenses.

Stewart then told Wolgamot that he would be returning to court on Tuesday, and at that time, he would find out if a criminal complaint had been filed. He added if a complaint is filed, he would be provided a copy of it and the court would review the charges it contained with him.

If no complaint is filed, Stewart said that Wolgamot would be released. Wolgamot is currently being held without bond and can request the court to appoint the Yuma County Public Defender's Office to represent him at his next hearing if he can not afford to hire his own attorney.

According to Sgt. Lori Franklin, spokesperson for the Yuma Police Department, Wolgamot was arrested and booked into the Yuma County Detention Center on Thursday.
