Former police officer's arraignment on child rape charges rescheduled

Carl Kannenberg, the former Montville Township police officer charged with raping a 6-year-old girl, was scheduled to be arraigned Wednesday, but the arraignment was continued and will be rescheduled for a new date.

He is charged with two counts of rape, two counts of gross sexual imposition and two counts of kidnapping. Kannenberg allegedly engaged in anal penetration and inappropriate sexual contact.

According to the indictment, Kannenberg sexually abused the child two times. The first charge lists the location as Kannenberg's Medina County home, happening at some point between Sept. 1, 2015 and Jan. 31, 2016. The second charge, which happened between Feb. 1 and Feb. 3, 2016, does not list a location, but reports say that it occurred at University Hospital.

"Patient safety is our highest priority," UH said in a statement. "UH takes the safety of our patients very seriously. We are continually refining and strengthening our protocols to maintain a safe environment for our patients and their families."

Kannenberg, 34, of Brunswick, was arrested on July 12 by the Cleveland Police Department and was released on July 14.
