A state corrections officer and her 16-year-old son were arrested Wednesday at their Ogden home.

NEW HANOVER COUNTY -- A state corrections officer and her 16-year-old son were arrested Wednesday at their Ogden home, accused in the sexual assault of a 9-year-old girl.

Charri Raye Russell, 38, is charged with one count of felony child abuse for allowing the molestation of the girl, according to the arrest warrant. The offense happened between March and August.

Russell's son, Talan Kingsley, 16, is charged with indecent liberties with a child and statutory sex offense of the same girl, the arrest warrant shows.

Mother and son were arrested Wednesday morning at the family home on Middle Sound Loop Road.

Russell is a correctional officer III at Tabor Correctional Institution, according to a November 2016 Department of Public Safety newsletter.

Russell's bail is set at \$150,000. Kingsley's bail is set at \$250,000.
