


Police officer caught in undercover sting of sexual predators

Police in Virginia went undercover to catch predators online — and they caught a cop.

Montgomery County Police Officer Christopher B. Dunkes, 27, was one of seven people arrested this month as part of a perv sting

by Prince William County police, authorities said.

The creeper cop fell for a Craigslist ad by an undercover officer posting as a 15-year-old, according to the Washington Post.

During the week-long operation, which started June 6, police posed as underage users looking for sex online.

In Dunkes' case, he emailed and texted the undercover officer about sex before suggesting they meet in his car, police said.

The Maryland officer drove to a Target store to meet the agent — and then the cop became a criminal, when officers waiting there nabbed him.

Dunkes, who joined the force in February 2014, is now being held without bond on charges of using a communication device to facilitate offenses with juveniles, court records show.

He has been suspended without pay, the department said.

A department spokesman could not immediately comment on whether Dunkes had faced disciplinary problems on the job.

The sting also led to the arrests of six men in Virginia — Steven Castillo, 26, of Woodbridge; Jeffrey Diamond, 35, of Fredericksburg; Curtis Jenkins, 54, of Fairfax; Jordan Kolbinskie, 23, of Manassas; David Lee Mathes, 58, of Warrenton; and Chad Warner, 24, of Sterling. All have been charged for their communications.
