

Texas cop accused of sexually assaulting girl every week

San Antonio Officer Juan Ruiz-Carrillo was busted for sexually assaulting a child.

San Antonio's police chief admitted an "embarrassment to the department" as an officer was arrested for sexually assaulting a girl nearly every week for four years, starting when she was 15.

The girl told a youth pastor at her church about the abuse, and her parents were notified.

Officer Juan Ruiz-Carrillo, 47, told the victim that he would kill himself if she ever reported him, according to the arrest warrant obtained by the San Antonio Express-News.

The disgraced cop was arrested Monday night for sexually assaulting a child and remained in custody Wednesday morning, according to the newspaper.

Ruiz-Carrillo actually called in sick to work on Monday just an hour before he was supposed to report for duty, perhaps knowing that officers were waiting to arrest him, the paper reported.

Authorities ended up spending "a long time looking for him," but arrested him "without incident," Police Chief William McManus told the paper.

"We were actually waiting for him to come in," McManus said. "We had the paperwork ready to go put him on administrative leave at that point."

Ruiz-Carrillo is a five-year veteran of the force.

"There is no one in this police department that is pleased by this or happy about this," McManus told the paper. "Officers take great pride in their jobs, and no one wants to see an officer who's been convicted or who's been involved in something like this remain on the department."
