Former Harriman police officer turns himself in after child sex charges

Former Harriman police officer, Michael Paul McPeters, turned himself in after facing four counts involving sexual activity with a minor who is less than 13-years-old.

Those with the Harriman Police Department said the officer hasn't been with the department for nearly 15 years. His resignation date is listed as 2001.

According the Harriman Police Department, McPeters went on to work for Wackenhunt Security Company. The company oversees security at Y-12 Nuclear Complex in Oak Ridge. Those with the Harriman Police Department say McPeters worked for the Morgan County Sheriff's Office at some point in his career as well.

McPeters immediately bonded out.

Court documents show the alleged sexual contact happened between August 1, 2013 and September 29, 2013.

The first count alleges McPeters engaged in sexual activity for the victim to view via electronic communication.

The second count alleges McPeters intentionally engaged in sexual contact with the child by touching the child's intimate parts for sexual arousal.

The third count alleges McPeters showed the victim pictures or drawings of nudity or sexual conduct.

The fourth count alleges McPeters persuaded the minor to engage in sexual activity or simulated sexually activity for him to view.
