

OKC Officer Charged for Alleged Domestic Abuse

(KFOR) OKLAHOMA CITY – An Oklahoma City police officer has officially been charged for domestic abuse.

Mustang police officers were called to a home in the 700 block of East Olivia Terrance in May on reports of a domestic abuse incident.

When they arrived, they took MSgt. Greg Driskill, a 16-year veteran with the Oklahoma City Police Department, into custody on one complaint of domestic abuse and one complaint of assault and battery with a dangerous weapon.

He was booked into the Mustang Municipal Jail.

On Tuesday, Driskill has been formally charged in Canadian County District Court with feloniously pointing a firearm and assault and battery domestic abuse.

Officials say Driskill continues to be on administrative leave from the Oklahoma City Police Department.
