

## Ansonia police officer arrested in connection with alleged Milford domestic dispute

ANSONIA >> One of Ansonia Police Department's own has been arrested and charged following a "domestic incident" he allegedly was involved in over the weekend in Milford.

Officer Christopher Kelley was charged by Milford police with one count of disorderly conduct following an incident that allegedly occurred during the overnight hours Sunday in that city, according to a press release Tuesday from Ansonia police Lt. Andrew Cota.

Cota said Kelley has been placed on paid administrative leave, pending the outcome of the case. An Internal Affairs investigation by Ansonia police will be conducted in conjunction with the case, Cota said.

Cota said Ansonia police were notified April 24 that Kelley "had been involved in a domestic incident" in Milford. It was then learned that Milford police had completed an arrest warrant for Kelley related to the incident, which then was then signed by a Superior Court judge.

Kelley turned himself in to police Monday and was released on a promise to appear in Superior Court in Milford the next day, according to Cota.

Kelley has been with the Ansonia Police Department since July 2013.

Cota said no further information about the incident would be released at this time. Cota Tuesday said he did not have immediate access to Kelley's personnel file, and it was not known whether Kelley had any previous issues on his file while on the police force here.

Cota said while he could not confirm whether Kelley was a Milford resident at the time of the incident, he believes Kelley was in the process of moving.
