

Toledo officer accused of domestic violence

A Toledo police officer has been charged with domestic violence and suspended.

Officer Douglas Lewis, 44, was arrested after an incident about 7 p.m. May 22 at a Toledo home. His wife, Kristina Lewis, 45, said he sent her text messages and was loading items at the home when she arrived, according to a police report.

Ms. Lewis told police the officer used profane language, repeatedly pushed her, and shoved her head toward the ground. He drove through the yard in his truck, she said.

He has not lived at the property since September, she said.

Police also cited him with failure to control, failure to stop after a collision, and making false alarms for a crash about 10:45 p.m. May 26. His vehicle struck the side of a parked car in the 4600 block of Luann Avenue, police said. Police later alleged that Officer Lewis drove the car and falsely reported it as stolen.

Officer Lewis, who declined to comment, has pleaded not guilty in Toledo Municipal Court to all charges. A department spokesman said an internal affairs probe is ongoing.
