

Deputy arrested for drugs arrested again on four felony charges [bakersfield.com](#)

A Kern County Sheriff's deputy who was arrested Friday on suspicion of being on drugs while working at the courthouse was arrested again Saturday night on four felony counts including spousal abuse and child cruelty.

Gideon Allday, 26, was booked into the downtown jail on \$110,000 bail.

He was arrested by the Bakersfield Police Department at 10:43 p.m. Saturday on suspicion of spousal abuse, willful cruelty to a child, false imprisonment with violence, threaten with intent to terrorize and two misdemeanor charges of possession of concentrated cannabis and drug paraphernalia.

The Kern County Sheriff's Office declined to comment as this is a police matter.

Allday, who's worked for the Sheriff's Office since February 2012, is on paid administrative leave related to the first charges.

In the first incident, other deputies noticed Allday was displaying "unusual behavior" while working at the courthouse about 9:30 a.m. Friday, according to sheriff's officials.

He was evaluated and it was determined he was under the influence.

The substance wasn't immediately known.

A hearing on the new charges is scheduled for 3 p.m. Tuesday.
