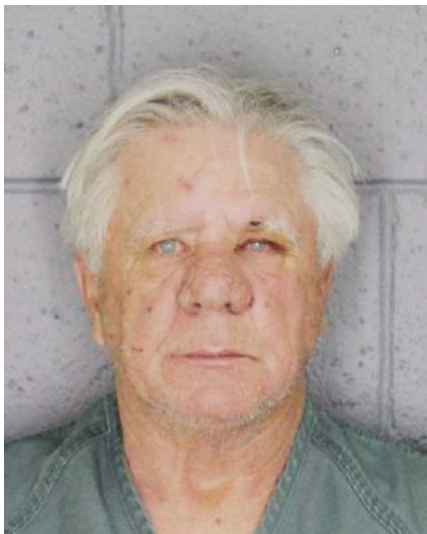


Charles Wilkinson, retired Nassau cop, killed wife, spent weekend with body, authorities say - Newsday
