

America's Trafficked Children Are Being Arrested, Not Rescued

This was the topic of an **unprecedented** congressional briefing on capitol hill that took place yesterday. Co- sponsored by the Caucus on Victims' Rights and the Caucus on Human Trafficking, Congressman Chris Smith, Congressman Ted Poe, and Congressman Jim Costa were attentively listening to the challenges and recommendations of the panelists in addressing child sex slavery in America. In addition to the Congressman in attendance - the room was packed with nearly 80 congressional staffers and professionals. A clear message was sent that we are concerned about every victim exploited through the crime of human trafficking and that includes hundreds of thousands of American kids - every year.

The congressional briefing was spurred by the National Report on Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking:

America's Prostituted Children written by Shared Hope International. The report reveals the shocking findings of three years of intensive research on the issue of child sex trafficking in America from ten locations across the U.S. While the research locations ranged from areas as diverse as Salt Lake City, Utah to Clearwater, Florida and Las Vegas, Nevada the findings were hauntingly similar - underage American girls are the bulk of victims in commercial sex markets and are too often being arrested rather than rescued. Additionally, nearly every interview revealed that American child sex trafficking victims were being misidentified or not identified at all by Child Protective Services and social service providers who are responsible for providing proper treatment and care. The arrest and lack of specialized services for these children is **causing** revictimization.

Important key findings:

- At least 100,000 children are used in prostitution every year in the United States.
- The average age of entry into prostitution is 13 years old.
- Prostituted girls are often controlled by a pimp who recruits them into sex trafficking by posing as a boyfriend, caretaker, and protector.
- The 3 primary manifestations of child sex trafficking in America is: pimp-controlled prostitution, familial prostitution, and/or survival sex.
- The business of sex trafficking of America's youth is flourishing as demand for commercial sex with young, innocent girls and boys continues to occur with little and low punishment.
- Child sexual slavery is fueled by a cultural of tolerance which glorifies pimping and normalizes the sexual exploitation of children.

Domestic minor sex trafficking is a serious problem in the U.S., and one that will not be solved

overnight. But the first step is admitting to ourselves that it's not just foreign kids who are vulnerableit's our kids. And this report is the first step to learning to admit that.

Trafficking of women from Nepal exposed

MADURAI: Maiti, a non-governmental organisation with its headquarters in Kathmandu, Nepal, has rescued over 500 young women and girls from Nepal, who had been trafficked to India by agents and forced into prostitution, Uma Tamang, an advocate from the NGO, said here on Tuesday.

She had come to Nilakkottai judicial magistrate court to take charge of a Nepali woman, Manisha (name changed), who was arrested by the police at Batlagundu in Dindigul district during the last week of July this year. Uma Tamang, who had accompanied the brother of the woman, to take custody of Manisha, said that the MAITI was working with assistance from the United Nations to prevent trafficking and over the years, it had identified Nepali girls in various States of India and had had them repatriated to Nepal. This was the first time that a Nepali had been rescued from Tamil Nadu. "But it looks like only the tip of the iceberg', she commented.

The Nepali woman, though she is said to be 21 years old, looks like a 16-year-old. She was arrested with five other women at a brothel in Batalgundu and detained in prison.

Two Madurai-based NGOs, the Foundation for Human Rights and Development (FOHRD), and the DEEPS, filed a plea before the Madurai Bench of the High Court seeking custody of the women so that they could rehabilitate them.

Justice G M Akbar Ali, before whom their petition came up, directed that the women be released from prison and handed over to the NGOs, and that they be treated as victims of trafficking and not as criminals.

The judge also directed the NGOs to trace the women's parents and send them back to their families.

The director of FOHRD, Syed Ahamed, had contacted Anuradha Koirala, the director of MAITI, in Kathmandu, and had sought her help to trace the relatives of the woman.

Manisha had told the NGO that she was from a distant district in Kathmandu and that she had been brought to India by a man named Supaya Tamang and sold to some persons, who had brought her to Dindigul.

With the details given by Manisha, MAITI had traced her parents and with its help, her brother Bier Bahadur accompanied by Uma Tamang and another officer had come to Nilakkottai to take charge of Manisha.

The FOHRD had obtained an order for repatriation from the Madurai Bench of the High Court on Tuesday for Manisha.
