	According to their website, many of the calls relating to 'potential victims referenced' are <i>follow up calls</i> , so the actual number of calls directly relating to the 'potential victims referenced' may be many fewer. Here is a link to their final 2011 annual report: <a href="#">"Increasing Awareness and Engagement- Strengthening the National Response to Human Trafficking in the US"</a> According to their press release, "Call Specialists answered 19,427 calls, and 2,945 victims of human trafficking were connected to services and support." We don't know how they came to this number as the reported calls were far fewer.... also, we don't know which victims of human trafficking were from prostitution and which were from other areas of forced labor.						<b>7,909</b>
